



Babes in Arms Policy

The Lights encourages access for all, however, we would recommend that parents or guardians do not bring infants less than two years of age into the auditorium. Should you wish to attend performances for children and families with an infant aged below two years, they will need to be accommodated on the parent or guardian's lap as no seat will be allocated. There will be no charge for this. Children over the age of two require a seat and therefore a paid ticket. Should the babe in arms become restless and cause a disturbance, the parent/guardian will be requested to leave the auditorium with the child so as not to disturb other customers. For all other shows, we kindly request patrons contact the box office in advance to ascertain whether a performance is deemed to be suitable for young babies by the management of The Lights.
